

## Attachment A: Standard Text for Promotion of Skills Checkpoint for Older Workers Program and the Skills and Training Incentive by Training Organisations

The Australian Government, through its Skills and Training Incentive (**Incentive**), is providing up to \$2,200 (GST inclusive) to fund training to help mature age Australians to update their skills and remain in the workforce longer.

You are eligible for the Incentive if you:

- are aged 45-70
- are an Australian citizen or permanent resident
- are currently employed OR recently unemployed (within nine months) and not registered with an Australian Government employment services provider
- have completed a Skills Checkpoint assessment that identified training opportunities through the Skills Checkpoint for Older Workers Program (Program).
